

TOEICスコア・LCSスコア 相関表及びレベル別分布表

下記表の左半分は、今回TOEICテストを受験された293名のTOEICスコアと、そのスコアから算出したLIOJのクラス編成に必要な『LCS』(LIOJ Community Score)の相関関係を表した表です。

例えば、LCS200~300のレベルを例にとってみますと、このレベル内には96名の方がおり全体の32.8%を占めています。 そして、その96名の方のTOEICスコアは235~435点の間に分布しています。

LIOJ COMMUNITY COURSE FOR SPRING 1986

- *ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CLASS: (Once a week on TUE.WED.THU.FRI. or SAT. for 11 weeks)
 It is easier for children to learn to speak a foreign language. At LIOJ students have the opportunity to listen and speak to non-Japanese. This interaction increases students confidence in using English.
- *JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL CLASS: (Once a week on Wednesday for 11 weeks)
- *SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CLASS: (Once a week on TUE.THU.FRI.SAT.for 11 weeks)

 The emphasis of both courses is to offer students a real life situation in which to practice the English they have learned at school. The courses are not designed to help students pass an entrance examination but provide the opportunity to use the spoken language. LIOJ hopes that these students will begin to find English more interesting.
- *LADIES CLASS: (Once a week on Wednesday for 10 weeks, 5 classes)

 This course is offered to ladies only on Wednesday morning. It is for someone who has studied English when she was a student and is still interested in learning English or is for someone who has free time and is looking for something to do after raising their children. There are 5 levels so that women with many different levels can attend.
- *TUESDAY NIGHT SCHOOL: (Once a week on TUE. for 10 weeks, 2 classes)
 *WEDNESDAY NIGHT SCHOOL: (Once a week on WED. for 10 weeks, 6 classes)
- *THURSDAY NIGHT SCHOOL: (Once a week on THU. for 10 weeks, 6 classes)
 Our students, aged 18 to 60, have a variety of backgrounds, such as businessmen, office ladies, engineers, university students and housewives. Night school provides them with a

ladies, engineers, university students and housewives. Night school provides them with a chance to use the English they have studied by themselves during the week and keeps up their interest in learning English. There are many levels in order to provide adequate lessons for all students.

Tuesday 2 classes:

**Class A LIOJ Community Score(LCS) 330 - 390

**Class B LIOJ Community Score(LCS) 490 and higher

Wednesday 6 classes:

**All classes LIOJ Community Score(LCS) 0 - 489

Thursday 6 classes:

**All classes LIOJ Community Score(LCS) 0 - 489

*BUSINESS ENGLISH CLASS(B.E.C.):(Once a week on WED. or THU. for 10 weeks)

This class is designed especially for businessmen who need English for their jobs and are interested in International Business Communication. Class includes various materials and methods which have been developed in our residential course for businessmen over the past 16 years.

Wednesday 1 class: LIOJ Community Score(LCS) 300 - 390

LIOJ Community Score(LCS) 391 and higher

- *SEMI-INTENSIVE CLASS: (Two times a week on MON. & THU. for 10 weeks, 3 classes)

 LIOJ recommends this course to people who really want to improve their English skills.

 This course is for beginning and basic level students. There are a small number of students who meet twice a week for 4 hours.
- *FRENCH CONVERSATION FOR BEGINNERS:(Once a week on Thursday for 10 weeks)

 Parlez-vous francais? English is the international language of the world, but French is the most beautiful. LIOJ's French students practise the basic expressions, such as greetings, invitations and requests. The main materials are the introducctory text Sans Frontieres, traditional French songs, and sometimes a little French wine and cheese. In class, French is spoken only, but after class you can ask questions in English or Japanese. If you would like to join the group, please ask the LIOJ office for preparatory materials. This course is for beginners. Bienvenue!

- *** TOEIC TEST SCORE IS REQUIRED TO TAKE LIOJ COMMUNITY COURSES EXCEPT Elementary class, Junior and Senior High school classes.
- *** LIOJ stresses the communicative skills of listening comprehension and speaking in its community programs. For this reason, a heavier stress is being put on the TOEIC listening comprehension score. However, since the reading section of the TOEIC contains vocabulary and grammar as well as reading comprehension, a percentage of the total reading score will be added to the listening comprehension score. To figure the score, take 40% of the total reading score and add it to the listening comprehension score. This score will be your LIOJ community score.
